From a short poem that makes you laugh but lingers after the laughter has ended like There are Fascists, or troubles you like The Stranger, or surprises, moves and uplifts you like Defying Gravity (my favourite McGough poem of all) there is something here for everyone. And for those who have never read Roger McGough this collection will be an unparalleled, joyous voyage of discovery.
