These six books from Jewish Lights Publishing are another reminder of the range and breadth of the publications of these publishers who have probably done more to revive Jewish interest in Jewish subjects and issues in America and Europe than anyone else for several decades.

This selection is a pot-pourri of delights. Rami Shapiro translates his favourite Chasidic tales (a boon to any rabbi desperate for a sermon topic come Shabbat) and annotates them clearly and helpfully. Neil Gillman presents the Jewish teachings on God and the Jewish approach to God in a way that will clarifying to Jews as well as helpful to Christians, and of great benefit in interfaith dialogue groups. Daniel Polish trawls through the inexhaustible depths of the Psalms to present a way of coping with the challenges of life and its conflicts that utilises the Psalms' timeless wisdom and spiritual comfort and courage. Norman J Cohen brings together a variety of texts that illustrate the importance of being there for others and relating to them, as well as gaining control over the needs of the self. Vanessa and Elizabeth Ochs charmingly explore the world of dreams both from a classical Jewish and a modern perspective, adding study sources and ways of response that those with a vivid dream life will find fascinating. And finally, master storyteller Howard Schwartz brings vividly to life eleven wonderful stories centred on Jerusalem that will entrance children of all ages.

Whatever you choose from this eclectic collection you will be well rewarded.
