The quotes themselves come under a range of headings from A–Y, including such predictable topics as Age and Aging, Change, Children, Death and Grief, Morality and Ethics, Women but also the less predictable such as Civil Rights, Social Movements and Activism, Fashion and Shopping, The Human Body…and Its Parts, Marriage, Husbands, Wives and Divorce, Racism, Sexism and Other Prejudices. Some of the quotations are excellent, others are less so, and a few are very poor, but overall this is a collection that will give pleasure to all devotees of such anthologies.

The Creative Jewish Wedding Book is one of those publications at which Jewish Lights Publishing excels. Approaching its subject in a way that includes almost all types of Jew, Gabrielle Kaplan-Meyer has amassed a huge amount of information, wonderful practical suggestions and really helpful advice.
